<u>lechyd a Lles / Health and Well-being</u>- <u>Who were Florence Nightingale and Betsi Cadwaladr and why were they important?</u> How have rights of children changed since the Victorian era? We will compare these two important women and their impact on the world of medicine. As part of this, we will look at how the lives of children changed in the last 200 years. We will compare school work and health during the Victorian era with present day.



Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol / Expressive Arts- What type of art was famous in the Victorian era? We will create our own silhouette pictures and use Artificial Intelligence to shrink portraits to miniatures. We will look at influential artists of the time and emulate this style. We will take part in a drama workshop to role-play the life of a Victorian child. We will use animation software to create a short film starring a locomotive.



<u>Y Dyniaethau / Humanities - Was the Victoria era a time of great change?</u> We will look at how the Victorians got their name and what life was like in the Victorian period. We will create a timeline of key events and changes during that era. We will explore how some inventions like steam trains and the telephone changed the world. We will try to understand how the industrial revolution caused changes in population in our local area compared with today.
